Title of the scenario: Autumn wear

Grade/ age of students: 2.5 – 3 y.o.

Duration: 45 minutes

Methodology of the teaching scenario

Purpose and objective:

- * developing musical and emotional sensitivity by listening to music,*
- * developing musical and movement activities,*
- * enjoying the fun together.*

General reference to the pre-work:

No pre-work is necessary at this stage.

Necessary materials:

Musical instruments: tambourine, triangle, maracas, drum

Computer with loudspeaker.

Cognitive areas involved:

Social, kinesthetic, memory

Description of the teaching scenario

1. *Greeting the children by the teacher with a song with showing: "Let's welcome winter by stroke our bellies and our little noses, let's clap our feet clap loudly just like that, just like that"*
2. *Talk and presentation of musical instruments and of how to play, determining the sounds that they can have the opportunity to play the instrument*
3. *Imitation play. Children sit in a circle and listen to the teacher saying, "It is raining, it is blowing strong" and imitate the sounds they hear (rain, wind, thunder) according to the caregiver's instructions.*

4. *Movement and imitation play. The children stand scattered and sing the song "Bad Weather" where they march, dance and tap the rhythm.*

5. *Thank to the children for participating in the classes.*

General conclusion:

Children have the opportunity to work together. They learn how to cooperate and also that music can go along with hearing, dancing, singing so there's a place for everyone to be involved. The important factor is playing the instruments of the choice without any impositions.

Continuation:

The activities can be continued with other exercises connected with music: it may include animals and their preparation for winter: hedgehogs, squirrels, bears, birds. There are lots of songs about that.
