

Musical activities for classroom

Form of the group: circle

Level: Preschool

Type of Game: Team hiding game

Objective: Teambuilding, turn taking, fun

Lyrics:

Where are the children, wish I knew / Where are the children, peek a boo

Directions

Kids standing in a circle, holding a lycra circled cloth. They all sing this song and move the cloth up and down to the beat.

Teacher asks kids to close their eyes. Then teacher touches some kids backs who then they go under the lycra cloth.

When kids go under the cloth then the song is split in two phrases.

Team 1 (standing in circle) sing: "Where are the children"

Team 2 (kids under the cloth) sing: "Wish I knew"

Team 1: "Where are the children"

Team 1 & 2: "Peek a boo" they sing and kids Team 2 jump up high while team 1 lift the cloth high.

Repeat the activity so other students take their turn under the cloth.

Tips: Teacher asks from students to guess (with eyes closed) which children hide under the cloth. Kids should recognize them through their voices.
